In the event that any maintenance is required on the Powercor powerlines on your property, we will endeavour to inform you when we return to carry out this work.

Maintaining a safe and reliable electricity supply

As your electricity distributor, Powercor owns and operates the largest electricity distribution network in Victoria.

Our role is to develop and maintain the equipment on the electricity network such as the poles and wires, and be responsible for its performance. This means that it is our job to provide you with a reliable power supply and to keep you and your community safe from any potential danger caused by faulty electricity distribution equipment.

One way we do this is by regularly inspecting the condition of all the equipment on our electricity network.

Each year, Powercor invests millions of dollars in network inspection and maintenance programs in order to help keep the power on and the community safe.

Inspecting Your Private Overhead Electric Lines (POELs)

Under the Electricity Safety Act 1998 and the Electricity Industry Act 2000, Powercor is required and authorised to inspect the condition of any POELs you may have on your property. Powercor authorises Electrix, a network inspection contractor, to conduct these inspections on our behalf.
